At the University of Missouri, the Men's Basketball won 4 consecutive Big 8 Championships. While at University of Alaska Fairbanks, Dr. Lashbrook created the Top of the World Basketball Tournament.




#### Keir Radnedge, World Soccer Journalist, Author, & Broadcast Analyst

Michele introduced anti-doping programmes into professional golf (for the PGA European Tour, Ladies European Tour and the The R&A) and is currently preparing for golf's inclusion in the 2016 Olympic Games in Rio.

Formerly UK Director of Ethics and Anti-Doping, Michele has combined a background in education (teaching and lecturing), sport science (coaching) and policy administration (UK Sport) with a growing interest in sports law (governance, arbitration and mediation). She designed and implemented the international standards currently used for doping control, results management and education; her expertise in policy implementation led to the UK achieving the first ISO certification for anti-doping in the world and Drug Information Database. Michele has significant experience of anti-doping programmes at high profile events (Commonwealth Games, Six Nations Rugby, Rugby World Cups, Euro '96, World Indoor Athletics, World Student Games as well as innovative programmes such as the social drugs testing programme for the Football Association.

McGovern Museum of Health & Medical Science, the Houston Texans YMCA and the Touchdown Club of Houston. He is currently on the board at County Christian School in Ashburn, Va.

- One-gallon clear plastic freezer bag (Ziploc bag or similar)
- Small clutch bags, approximately the size of a hand, with or without a handle or strap
- Exceptions will be made for medical necessary items after proper inspection.

Prohibited items include, but are not limited to: handbags larger than a clutch bag, coolers, briefcases, backpacks, bum bags, cinch bags, seat cushions, luggage of any kind, computer bags, camera bags and any other bag larger than the permissible size.
